Minutes from DIBCA Spring Meeting: 11/5/18

Attendance/Call to Order: (Mike Sanford) 6:54

-Mike Sanford went through the minutes of our previous meeting on 3/28/18 and the minutes were accepted by the association.

Treasurer's Report: (Mike Wagner)

DIBCA has \$2,435.01 in the bank. Not including dues that were collected at the meeting.

Scholarship Report:

The DIBCA Scholarship has given over \$25, 000 in scholarship away since it started. (2) Boys (2) Girls Applications. are available online and applications are due in February 15, 2019

Blue Gold Update: The game will be held on March 16, 2019 at the Bluecoats new stadium on the river front in Wilmington. Mike Wagner brought up the possibility of having a Delaware vs Philly senior All Star Game and DIBCA would like him to look into that possibility.

DIBCA Top 15 Voting: The association discussed the new online voting format for the DIBCA top 15 and voted to continue to select the DIBCA Top 15 via the online DIBCA Google

DIBCA voted on a rule that establishes that coaches are allowed to vote for their own players during the DIBCA Top 15 selection process.

Coaches vs Cancer Presentation: Mike Sanford presented the Coaches vs Cancer Competition of 2019 and Jason Plaia of Coaches vs Cancer talked about some of the great things that Coaches vs Cancer does in Delaware. This year's goal is to have 30 schools participate and raise \$10,000. This year's wrist band will be pink and there will be an email sent for coaches to sign up to participate.

NHSBCA Feedback and June Scholastic Event Presentation: Mike Sanford spoke about the NHSBCA Conference that he and Mike Wagner attended and the proposed models for June 21st 2019 and June 28th 2019. Very Important information was distributed via email prior to 11/5 for coaches to read and that material cites rules, regulations, and timelines for next June's event dates.
